Competition Scoring and Judging Criteria

The overall Ms. World Universal National Title holder is determined by the highest overall point score regardless of age. In Ms. World Universal, 25 y o and over once this has been decided the next highest point score 40 years old and over will win the Ms. World Universal Elite Title. Everyone who enters this section of the pageant will all vie for the Ms. World Universal Title. Runner up to Ms. World Universal, Ms. World Universal Elite, Miss Teen and Miss World Universal will be crowned Ms./Miss. Global World or Ms. Global World Elite and of course there are the side awards. . Ms. World Universal event gives every entrant the opportunity to win a major title.

Interview – 40 points

Outfit is interview appropriate, business or professional attire eg. Skirt, Suit, Pant Suit or Dress.

Judges will be looking at how the question is answered and will consider your confidence, knowledge of your answers, biography and your personal presentation and poise. There will be no religious or political questions.

Evening Gown – 35 points

You will be judged on poise, elegance, and style.

Fitness Wear Ms World Universal – 25 points

Can be tights, bike shorts, tennis skirt with appropriate top

Fun Fashion – 25 points

Miss Teen and Miss World Universal

Fun Fashion any choice of outfit that suits your personality.

On Stage Question – 10 points

If you reach the finals the judges will be looking for confidence and ability to answer the question directly with no hesitation (Sometimes participants skirt around the answer so practice answering directly). Don't be nervous, your answers will encompass yourself and should you win where you will take your title.

Age of Entry

On the first (1st) day of pageant:

Miss World Universal 19 – 24 years inclusive

Miss Teen World Universal – 14 – 18 years inclusive

Entry Fees

Final payment is due at least one (1) month prior to the first day of the pageant for you to be eligible to compete.

Pageant Rules

1. Good Sportsmanship is always required. No name calling, or physical/verbal interactions. This includes the parents and family members. We will disqualify contestants, if necessary, for un-sportsmanship like conduct.
2. Judges' decisions are final. No correspondence will be entered in to.
3. Title Holders are to return to the following years National Finals if they win a Title.
4. The pageant Directors have the right to change or substitute prizes due to availability and alter the pageant rules due to unforeseen circumstances. Size of crowns and trophies are approximate.
5. Your age is determined as of the date of the first (1st) day of the pageant at midnight.
6. The pageant will not disclose other contestant's names only the number of contestants.
7. All Fees must be paid in full, at least one (1) month prior to the first day of pageant before you are eligible to compete. A non-refundable deposit of \$150.00 AUD is due with your Application Form and Biography to confirm your entry.
8. The pageant or host hotel/facility is not responsible for injury to the contestant/family, or damage, loss or theft to their property. Please keep an eye on things and do not leave them unattended.
9. By paying the deposit, you give the pageant, its sponsors, and affiliates the right to use photos, videos, or any other forms of media and/or for promotional purposes.

10. Contestants are of good moral character and will not do anything that may negatively affect the reputation of the Ms. World Universal Event. If this occurs, the Ms. World Universal Directors reserve the right to remove any Titles won and the contestant shall return all prizes or pay the value of the prizes to Ms. World Universal
11. Contestant will not slander Ms. World Universal, its directors, peers, judges, volunteers, or anyone else affiliated with the pageant.
12. Ms. World Universal reserves the right to change, remove or substitute prizes of an equal or greater value. In the event a prize is not available at crowning, your prize will be posted, or a suitable substitute will be provided.
13. Contestants understand and agree that violating the above rules are grounds for removal from the competition or removal of all Titles and/or awards won without a refund.
